ACADEMIC CHALLENGE

To earn a trophy you must do 4 of the 6 challenges below:

1. Complete a Reflections project. Projects can be literature, musical composition, photography or visual arts. Turn in project and entry form by November 14th to the office. Details on Reflections rules can be found on the PTSA website: clydehillpta.org.
2. Complete a science project for Young Scientist Week, January 26-30. You will use the scientific process to explore a topic of your choice and create a display to be shared. Guidelines and details on Young Scientist Week will be distributed soon.
3. Complete a culture project to display at the April 22 Culture Festival and Potluck. You can choose any country you like, from your heritage or a country you would like to visit. Projects will be displayed on table tops so tri-fold poster board works great. Check out clydehillpta.org for fun ideas and guidelines.
4. Read 5 books at your reading level. Complete a book review for each. Book review forms can be found on the PTSA website (clydehillpta.org). Please be sure to use the form for your grade level. All five reviews must be turned in to the office by May 15.
5. Complete 8 hours of Math Whizz activities. Math Whizz is an online tutor used in Clyde Hill classrooms and supports our new math curriculum. It offers personalized math lessons based on your ability. Sign up at www.whizz.com/us/. As you register, you will come to a price confirmation page. Enter the Clyde Hill PTSA discount code Bellevue1 (case sensitive) and recalculate to receive the \$14.99 per month price. Within the Math Whizz program you can print out a time sheet proving your hours. Math Whizz time sheet must be turned in to the office by May 15.
6. Complete 5 hours of *All the Right Type*, the keyboarding program used by the Bellevue School District. *All the Right Type* is recommended for kids ages 8 and older and can be found online from various sources, including ingenuityworks.com. Parent must sign a student report confirming 5 hours and turn it in by May 15.
